Women Veteran's Memorial



The Women's Memorial 20th Anniversary Celebration Ceremony was held October 21, 2017 and it was a great program. Representatives from all branches of the service were sharing the Voices of Women.

Introducing the keynote speaker was General Ann Dunwoody, U.S. Army, Retired. She was the first women to obtain the rank of General as well as the first women to hold a four-star rank in the U.S. Army. General Dunwoody retired in 2012.

The keynote speaker was General Janet Carol Wolfenbarger, U.S. Air force, Retired. General Wolfenbarger was the first women, four-star general in the U.S. Air Force who served as the Eighth Commander of the Air Force Material Command from June 5, 2012 to June 8, 2015. General Wolfenbarger served for over 35 years.

President Emeritus of the Women's Memorial Foundation, Brigadier General Wilma L. Vaught, USAF, Retired, stated she is often credited with the idea for the memorial but in actuality it was three women veterans from Toledo, Ohio. Does anyone know their names?
