Applications now being accepted

Funding - Up to \$5000 will be awarded to promote collegiate level studies to a deserving United States veteran in the Toledo area.

Eligibility - All successful candidates must:

- Be a US Veteran
- Be entering/enrolled or currently attending an accredited college or university in the United States
- Demonstrate leadership and engagement in their community
- Be a current student veteran, as proven by a DD 214 and transcript
- Have received an honorable discharge

2018 Essay Topic - Two Part Submission

1) Statement of Purpose.

2)This year's essay topic is:How does your veteran experience reflect on your commitment to your field of study? (500-800 words)

Include your name and contact information at the top of your essay.

Additional Materials - A complete application must include:

- Current copy of your Resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Unofficial copy of current university transcript updated for the most recently completed semester or proof of enrollment
- One letter of reference from a professor, adviser or supervisor
- DD 214, Certificate of Discharge
